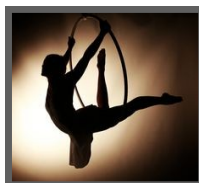


Best Lower School Attendance

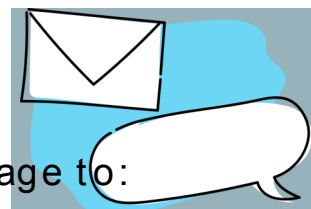
