Firstly, a huge **THANK YOU** for the continuous support the P.E. department receives. We had to rearrange our Yr3/4 boys football training due to upcoming fixtures. We would like to apologise for the confusion caused, however would like to again thank parents for their engagement with all after school club, we saw double the amount of children from the first week. We have the boys Yr 5/6 BPSSA tournament on Thursday this week. Letters have been sent out to those chosen to represent the school – A reminder to hand reply slips in **ASAP** please. We would like to share some engagement figures with you to showcase our passion of 'Sport for All' this year. Currently **97/611** children have engaged with after school clubs with 52 of those chosen to represent the school following trials. Our objective for this year is to engage as many children as possible, with a view of increasing participation levels in school games events. Our current figures for November show a **6%** increase in ASC engagement and tournament participation since October and a **9%** increase since September, showing positive movements towards achieving this goal.
