A huge well done to **Kassidy Flannagan** who is having her hair cut for

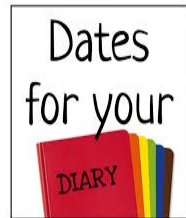

Perhaps they have terrible tantrums or emotional meltdowns. Maybe they can't make friends or play with their siblings. As for you, stress is a constant. Holding down a job may be too difficult. You may feel isolated from your friends, your community – perhaps even from your partner or your other children. You possibly feel guilty and don't know how to tackle your child's problem behaviour. If the pressure of raising a child with a special need is straining your family life, Stepping Stones Triple P may help.
