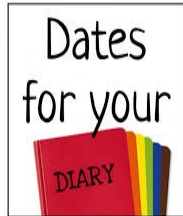
Message from the Head

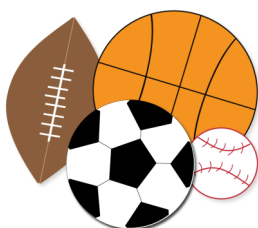
