Year 1 and Year 5 have had fire safety talks from our local fire brigade. I'm sure they will talk to you about fire safety plans and smoke detectors!

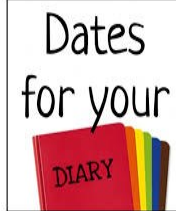
Monday sees the start of our nasal flu administrations. Please return the consent form as soon as possible if you haven't already done so.
